Is Las Vegas still Billy Walters' pushover? Signs of at least token resistance forming

City council decision will tell if it's all hype or a real fight

LAS VEGAS (July 19, 2005) - The first time Billy Walters stood to gain huge profits off a questionable deal involving the public land that became Royal Links Golf Club, Steve Miller felt like a lone man fighting against a tidal wave of power and entitlement.

Miller knew the Las Vegas city council was prepared to sell Walters the land for \$5,600 an acre even though some local real estate experts put its value at closer to \$40,000 an acre and adjoining land had sold for \$30,000 an acre. Miller was certain Las Vegas taxpayers were being had and just as certain that nobody in the local government cared to take a stand.

So Miller, a former city council member himself, became a one-man opposition party. He borrowed an automated dialing service from a friend and used it to phone 60,000 registered voters in Las Vegas. He laid out the basics of what he calls "the sweetheart of all sweetheart deals" in that automated message and urged any taxpayers who objected to call the city council, to call the mayor, to show up at the meetings and let their voices be heard.

"I became the tempest in the teapot because nobody else was looking into these things," Miller says now.

That was six years ago. Now Walters Golf owner Billy Walters is going back before the Las Vegas city council on Wednesday, August 3 asking that a deed restriction be lifted on that land he bought for \$5,600 an acre in 1999, so he can tear down Royal Links Golf Club and turn its 160 acres into a housing development, a move that could boast the land's value to an estimated \$400,000 an acre. This marks the third time the council is scheduled to discuss the plan, with the first two postponed amidst controversy.

then. Jones held up before TV cameras an article Miller wrote for an alternative weekly newspaper criticizing the deal and declared, "I take exception." Miller did lose a contentious 1991 mayoral election to Jones and he later filed a libel suit against Jones for a last-minute campaign flier that Miller claimed damaged his reputation with false accusations. In 1999, some officials tried to use this info to paint Miller as nothing more than a man with a grudge.

Attempting to discredit the source of news seems to come straight from the Walters Golf playbook. The company sued TravelGolf.com in what TravelGolf.com President Robert Lewis calls "an intimidation tactic" when unfavorable reviews came out on Stallion Mountain Country Club.

Only now, the Las Vegas Review-Journal has come out in opposition of this new Royal Links deal, the Better Business Bureau secured a rain check to Walters' Desert Pines for two Kentucky golfers unhappy with the greens, and the superintendent of Desert Pines hung up on a Golfweek reporter when pressed about fungus on those greens. Now, no one thinks an automated dialing service will be necessary to ensure that this Wednesday's 9 a.m. city council meeting is filled with curious citizens.

Billy Walters is actually offering to pay \$7 million for the right to get the deed restriction on the Royal Links land lifted. This \$7 million reflects the \$30,000-to-\$40,000per-acre price the land was appraised at in 1999 (a figure Walters Golf and city officials disputed in 1999) plus 6 percent annual interest.

The Las Vegas Review-Journal editorial recognizes this and still argues the deed restriction should be kept intact, however, noting Walters' projected \$54 million, "no-risk proposition" profit on what was taxpayers' land.

This isn't like 1999. Or is it?

Billy Walters For Miller, a veteran observer inside and out of the Las Vegas political machine, still expects the new current city council to approve the

"They'll make Walters sweat a little and they won't make the same kind of overt displays of support (the 1999 council) did," Miller says. "I think they'll all be very quiet, and careful not to say anything quotable, when this comes up on the agenda. But they'll vote it through.

"They'll sit there quietly and give Walters the votes he needs."

TravelGolf.com tried to contact Las Vegas city council members in the week before the July 20 meeting, but no calls were returned. A reporter specifically reached out to Councilman Steve Wolfson for an interview, requesting a phone interview or even an e-mail statement through his liaison. Wolfson, who has worked in both the Clark County District Attorney's Office and the United States Attorney's Office, did not respond.

Speaking in general, one of the city officials who handles the council's press requests said that council members "often do not want a comment about an issue before they've voted on it."

"I don't see any stand-up heroes on that council," Miller says.

Golfers aren't always interested in the politics. They are just wondering what's going to happen to Royal Links and if other Walters Golf courses will be headed for bulldozing with the Las Vegas real estate market booming.

"He's already torn down two of the three courses we're supposed to have at Stallion Mountain," Stallion member Art Olita says. "Who knows how long will have any course?"

Miller is convinced that Walters planned to demolish Royal Links all along, that making it a golf course for six years simply stood as a way to justify \$5,600 an acre.

"I think this has been planned from the beginning," Miller says. "And back in 1999, they probably thought this part of the deal would be a slam dunk as well."
